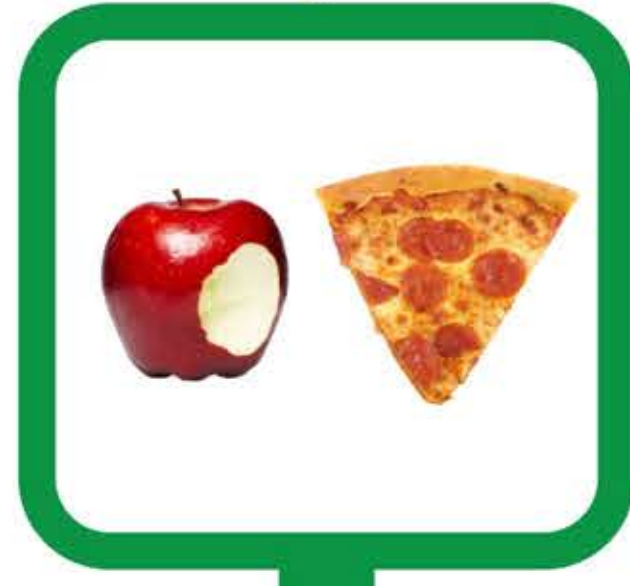

① Use Pictures

② Point Positive

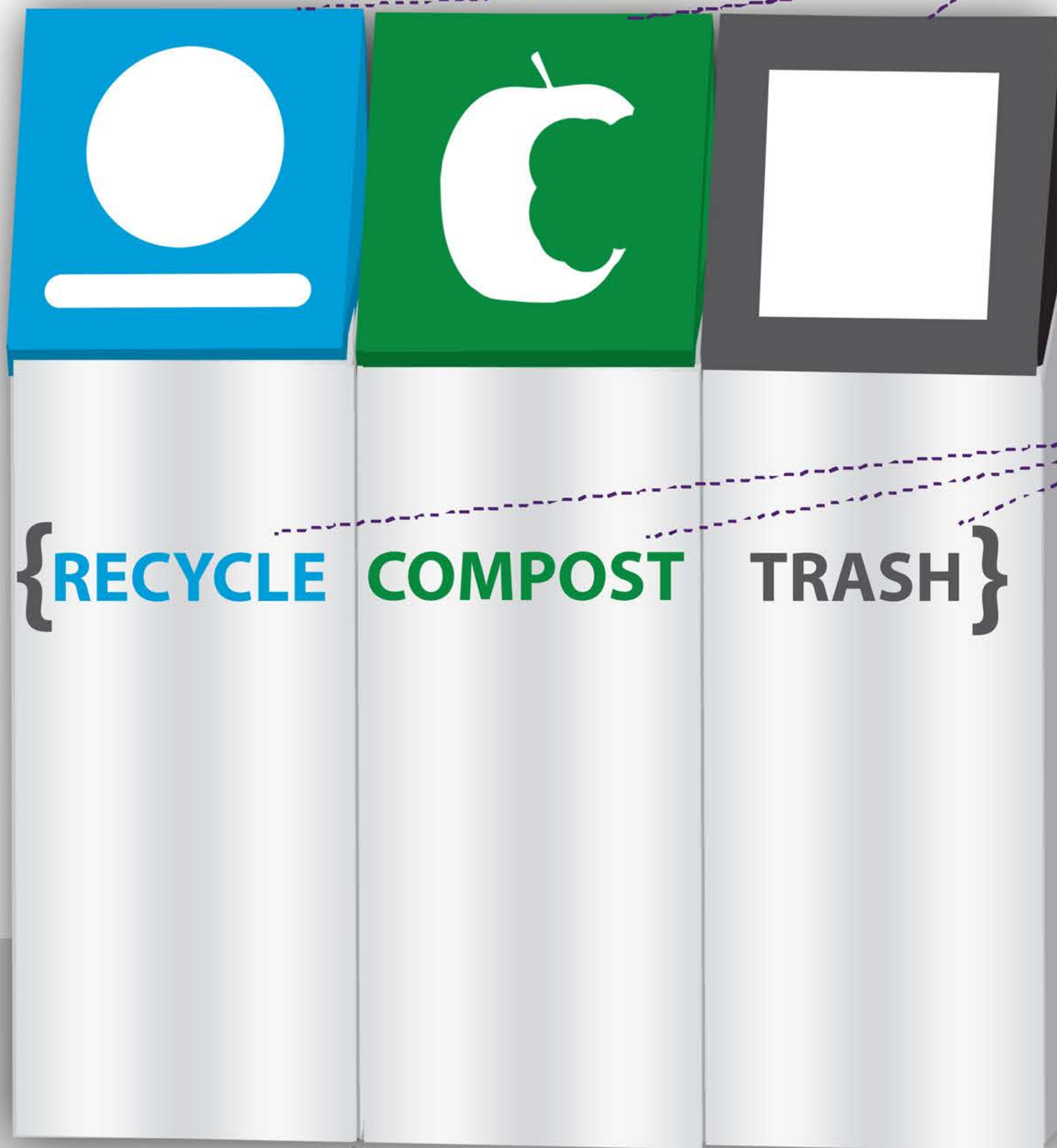
Use arrows to show where items should go.

③ Color Coordinate

Pair colors with categories. Match sorting categories with recognizable colors, and ALWAYS use the same color scheme throughout your establishment.

④ Place Your Signs Close

Place your signs as close to the point of disposal as possible.



⑤ Pair Bins

Create "recycling stations." Cluster organics, recycling and trash bins together to maximize convenience.
